QUALITY MANAGEMENT SCHEMES

(05/14) National Highway Sector Schemes (NHSS) relevant to the Specification for Highway Works are listed in Tables A/1 and A/2 following.

(05/14) NHSS are managed and developed in the UK by Technical Advisory Committees having representation from Highway Authorities, relevant Trade Associations, Certification Bodies and training organisations.

(05/14) The schemes will be identified separately within the scope of accreditation of each Certification Body. The Certification Body will be accredited by the United Kingdom Accreditation Service (UKAS) or equivalent European National Accreditation Body, which is party to a multi-lateral agreement (MLA) with UKAS or any equivalent International Accreditation Forum (IAF) MLA signatory, with a relevant scope.

Scheme 2C	The Design, Supply, Installation and Repair of Environmental Barriers (Structural) for Infrastructure Works (National Scheme applies)	Applies to all design, supply, installation and repair of fences excluding design and supply where these terms refer to the design or manufacture of products that fall within the scope of the Construction Products Regulation.
Scheme 3:	Stocking and Distribution Activities for Mechanical Fasteners (National Scheme applies)	Mandatory for non CE marked products. For all products if the stockist or distributor is registered under this scheme and applies the scheme to fasteners and associated items supplied under the Contract then the Contractor will be deemed to have satisfied the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Obtaining evidence of certification of the quality of the mechanical fasteners such as the manufacturer's Declaration of Performance under a CE mark, manufacturer's certificates and test reports from manufacturer's or suppliers. Review of the mechanical fastener documentation to confirm authenticity, relevance, accuracy and completeness. Inspection and sample testing of the mechanical fasteners to be used in the works in accordance with BS EN ISO 3269:2001, to confirm that the dimensional and mechanical properties comply with the product standard to which the mechanical fasteners have been manufactured.
